North Carolina Missions Offering (NCMO) is a special offering received during the month of September that supports the ministries of Baptists on Mission, Church Planting, mission camps, associational projects and mobilization ministry projects. NCMO is your opportunity to impact lostness as God accomplishes many wonderful things through these various ministries.

The theme for 2020 is “compelled by love” and the offering goal is \$2.1 million.

The theme verse is 2 Corinthians 5:14,

“For Christ’s love compels us, since we have reached this conclusion: If One died for all, then all died.”



*I*n a called business meeting after worship service on 8/30/20, with Dennis Jones-Deacon Chair presiding, the Finance Committee brought two motions before the church to be voted on. First, the 2020-2021 church budget proposal has been shared with the church body beginning two weeks ago and a discussion of the budget was held at 5:00 pm on 8/23/20 in the church sanctuary. This presentation was led by Mark Harris, chair of the Finance Committee. The Finance Committee presents the proposed budget to the church for final approval today. Since the motion to approve the proposed budget comes from the Finance Committee no second is required. The vote was taken by raised hands and unanimously approved by the members in attendance.

A second motion was brought by the Finance Committee concerning a proposed severance package for Pastor Matthew Price, who had submitted his resignation as Senior Pastor of Tabor City Baptist Church on 8/16/20 at conclusion of morning worship. With 30 days notice, the effective date of resignation will be 9/16/20. At the Deacon's meeting on 8/16/20, the deacon body voted to accept his resignation, effective 8/16/20 and discussed a severance package for Pastor Price using guidance from Section 1.4 of church bylaws.

After discussion, a motion was made and seconded that a lump sum severance package be paid as of the day of resignation on 8/16/20. The Deacon body voted and passed this recommendation unanimously. The recommendation was also approved by the Finance Committee. The Finance Committee brings this recommendation in the form of a motion to the church today for a yes or no vote. There was no discussion since this was presented by the Finance Committee at the budget discussion on the evening of 8/23/20. This motion comes from the Finance Committee and requires no second. The vote was taken by raised hands and passed by vast majority of those voting.

A matter of information was shared by Dennis Jones concerning the Nominating Committee report. We had planned to present and vote on this today. Due to issues beyond their control, the Nominating Committee is having to make some changes and updates and require additional time to complete their work. They will report back when that work is complete and the church will vote on that report. This completed our business matters and Dennis Jones called for adjournment and a second was made. After a short prayer members were dismissed.
