As we approach Easter weekend, my thoughts are drawn toward the beloved hymns that tell of the cross and the sacrifice of love that Christ made for us. The music this past Sunday was especially moving to me as we first sang songs Of Triumphant Entry that praised Jesus and then transitioned to *The Old Rugged Cross* and *The Power of the Cross*.

The choir has been working on an arrangement of *When I Survey the Wondrous Cross*, written by Isaac Watts, first printed in a hymnal in 1707, and considered by some Hymnology scholars to be the greatest English hymn written. There are several arrangements of this moving hymn that let the singer and listener express what Christ's sacrifice means to each of us. Take time to read and sing the words of this hymn as you reflect on Christ's purpose in your life during this special week of Easter.

When I Survey the Wondrous Cross

*When I survey the wondrous cross On which the Prince of glory died,
My richest gain I count but loss, And pour contempt on all my pride.*

*Forbid it, Lord, that I should boast, Save in the death of Christ my God!
