Wednesday 6:00 PM Service

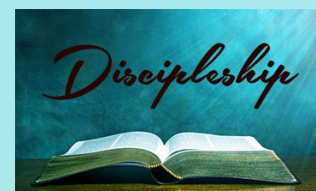
