- Pray for reliable cars, motorcycles, and scooters for missionaries to use.

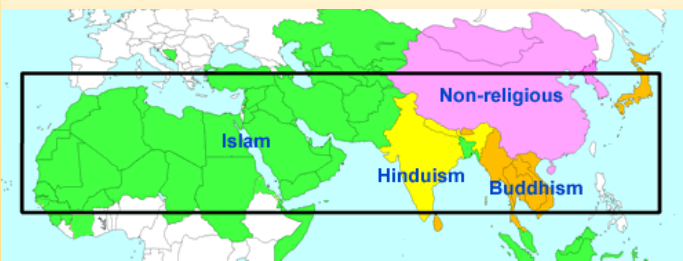

The 10/40 Window is a rectangular area located between latitudes 10 degrees north and 40 degrees north of the Equator. This area encompasses the part of the world that is home to the largest number of people with the lowest quality of life who have the least access to the Gospel. This area is the center of the world's major non-Christian religions of Islam, Buddhism, and Hinduism. There are also large number of Animists, Jews, and Atheists living in this region.
